

Top Raw Feeding Tips



GET FRIENDLY WITH YOUR LOCAL BUTCHER



Buy whole chickens and debone at home. Remove your breast meat and the dog has the rest. Costs less than buying breasts alone and you get some free dog food in exchange for a bit of butchery

Speak to friends and family about you raw feeding – you'd be surprised what you could use that they likely throw away

INVEST IN A CHEST FREEZER IF POSSIBLE



BUY BY THE BOX WITH FRIENDS IF YOU DON'T HAVE ENOUGH ROOM



Look through reduced sections at the supermarket

Use cheaper proteins as a staple of the diet (poultry), adding smaller amounts of the more expensive proteins/brands to keep costs to a minimum

Stock up on special offers with friends if you don't have room



Find a **RELIABLE** raw food source. The cheapest is hardly the best if they don't show up on delivery day and leave you having to buy elsewhere and spend even more money
